ORDER

1. An application Under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR no. 258 dated 1.12.2024 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC Police Station City Sangrur has been filed on behalf of applicant-accused.
2. Upon notice, Sh. Yashdeep Bhardwaj, Addl. PP appeared on behalf of State.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Addl. PP for the State and have gone through the record.

4 Applicant/accused Davinder Singh was admitted to interim bail vide order dated 24.12.2024 passed by this court, subject to condition that applicant/accused shall join the investigation within 7 days from that day. Today, ASI Kulwinder Singh no. 2526/SGR has made a statement in the court that applicant/accused Davinder Singh has joined the investigation on 31.12.2024 in compliance with the order dated 24.12.2024 passed by this Court. Custodial interrogation of applicant/accused Davinder Singh is not required. So keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case order dated 24.12.2024 passed by this court vide which accused/applicant Davinder Singh was admitted on interim bail is made absolute and stands confirmed. Thus, bail application is allowed. Applicant/accused Davinder Singh shall also comply with the following provision of Section 482(2) of BNSS:-

1. That the applicant/accused will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
2. That the applicant/accused will not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the court.
