ORDER:

1. This application regular bail has been moved on behalf of
applicant-accused Pritpal Singh @ Kalu for offences under Sections 379,
457, 380 and 411 IPC by virtue of Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Notice of this bail application has been given to State. Police
record has been requisitioned. Arguments have been heard and record has
been perused.

3. As per allegations, complainant Narinder Kumar is running a
saw mill (Aara) in the name and style of Garg Shah Mill situated at Patran
Road Lehra Kanchiyan. During the intervening of 25.08.2023, some

unidentified had committed theft of four batteries of four tractor, two batteries of generator, two drawers of two lift of tractor. As per CCTV footage, the said unidentified persons were four in number and now he has come to know that such persons were Pritpal Singh @ Kalu, Sanni, Chamkaur Singh @ Billa and Gursewak Singh @ Sewak. Complainant further submitted that out of aforesaid thieves, two thieves namely Pritpal Singh @ Kalu and Gursewak Singh @ Sewak were present along with stolen batteries at the shop of Shiv Kumar son of Jagdish Rai son of Panna Lal Aggarwal resident of Lehra for selling such batteries and if raid would be conducted at that place, they could be apprehended. On the basis of that case was got registered against above mentioned persons.

Thereafter, raid was conducted at the house of applicant-accused Shiv Kumar, where accused Pritpal Singh @ Kalu and Gursewak Singh @ Sewak were found present and four batteries and two lift drawers of tractor were recovered from the house of accused Shiv Kumar.

4. It may be submitted at the very outset that out of five accused, three accused i.e. applicant-accused Pritpal Singh @ Kalu, Shiv Kumar and Gursewak Singh @ Sewak have been arrested in the case and some part of recovery i.e. four batteries and two lift drawers of tractor has already been effected from the possession of such accused persons including present applicant-accused. Applicant-accused has been in custody since long. No useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody as the presentation of challan and its conclusion would likely to

take sufficient time and therefore, in the interest of justice applicant-accused Pritpal Singh @ Kalu is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Id. Ilaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:-

- 1 That applicant will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail;
- 2 That applicant will not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court;
- 3 That applicant will not induce the prosecution witnesses.

Police record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
