Instant application, praying for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, supported with affidavit, has been moved by applicants-accused **Smt. Reshma Bano, Abdul Hameed and Biryani @ Tehleen Bano** in Case Crime Number and Sections mentioned above.

In a nutshell, Prosecution Case is that informant Pooja has alleged that on 04.02.2025 at about 9:00 AM, her neighbors Reshma, Biryani, Abdul and their family members forcibly entered in her house and started hurling abuses towards her and her son Aadi and beaten her legs and fists due to which they sustained injuries. She has suspicion of any misconduct with her.

Heard learned counsel for applicants-accused and learned A.D.G.C (Criminal) for State and perused material available on record.

Learned counsel for applicants-accused has submitted that applicants are innocent, they have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. Summons has been served to the applicants and charge-sheet has already been filed in against them. Applicants are apprehending their arrest. Informant gave a criminal color to children fight. Applicants undertakes to cooperate in the investigation. Applicants have no previous criminal history.

*Per contra*, learned ADGC (Crl.) for State has submitted that having found plausible evidences, charge-sheet has already been filed against accused/applicants.

Perusal of record reveals that accused/applicants forcefully entered the house of informant and assaulted her as well as her son Aadi due to which informant sustained injuries. Applicants were released by police during investigation after receiving notice under Section 35(3) B.N.S.S.

Alleged offence entails punishment of less than or upto seven years.

After hearing learned counsels for parties at length, considering the facts and circumstances of the Case as well as the law propounded by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the authority of **Satender Kumar Antil Versus Central Bureau of Investigation & Anr. [(2022) 10 SCC 51]** (Order dated **21.03.2023** passed in Misc. Application in the said Case) as well as law propounded by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Lucknow Bench in the authority of **Smt. Bacchi Devi Versus State of U.P. and Anr.** (Order dated **12.08.2025** passed in Criminal Misc. Application u/s 528 BNSS Number 6400 of 2025), without commenting on merits of the Case, I find it a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

### **ORDER**

Accordingly, anticipatory bail application is **allowed**. In the event of appearance/arrest of applicants-accused in this Case, they shall be released on anticipatory bail, on their furnishing a personal Bond of **Rs. 50,000/-** alongwith one surety, in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Court concerned, subject to the following conditions:-

1. Applicants shall cooperate with trial and shall appear before the trial court on or before the next date fixed and execute bonds thereof;
2. They shall not tamper with the evidence(s) and shall neither allure nor intimidate nor influence any of the witness-(es).
3. They shall not seek any unnecessary adjournments and shall remain present, in person, before Court concerned on the dates fixed for opening of the case, framing of charge, and recording of statement under section 313 Cr.P.C.
4. In the event of default of any of the condition mentioned above, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the anticipatory bail granted to the applicants.
