Instant application, praying for bail under Section 483 BNSS, supported with affidavit, has been moved on behalf of applicant-accused **Akash Verma @ Natu** in Crime Number and Sections aforementioned.

In a nutshell, the Prosecution Case is that on 17.01.2025 at between 3-5 PM, informant Subhash Chandra has parked his scooty at Queen Merry Hospital, Chowk and secured with handle lock wherein when he returned at about 8:00 PM, his scooty was missing from the parking spot. It is further alleged that he kept his belongings like his Driving License, bank passbook and Rs. 4000/- in the scooty which also got stolen alongwith his scooty bearing regn. UP32 HF 9217.

Heard learned counsel for the accused/applicant as well as learned A.D.G.C (Criminal) for State and perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant is innocent, he has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. FIR is registered against unknown persons. There is an inordinate and unexplained delay in registration of FIR. Applicant has been falsely implicated in three other cases from the single recovery. Charge-sheet has already been filed in this case. There is no independent witness of the alleged offence. Applicant is not a previous convict. Applicant is languishing in jail since 21.01.2025.

Per-contra, learned ADGC (Criminal) has submitted that applicant alongwith co-accused stole scooty of informant from Queen Merry Hospital.

It has been alleged that applicant alongwith co-accused persons stole informant's scooty from Queen Merry Hospital. Applicant is not named in the FIR. During investigation, acting on a secret information, on 21.01.2025, Police caught on two suspects near Kukrail River bank beneath Bandha Road who disclosed their names as Akash Verma (accused/applicant) and ShyamJi @ Joja who was allegedly arrested alongwith informant's scooty, however, no independent or public witness has been enjoined with the alleged recovery. From the possession of accused/applicant, police recovered one Realme mobile phone and from

the possession of co-accused, police recovered Oppo mobile phone. Recovered mobile phones were stated to be stolen from several other places. Police also recovered RC, Driving License of informant and a UCO Bank passbook from the scooty which is connected with this case. They further confessed to commit the theft. Applicant is stated to be languishing in jail since 21.01.2025. Having found plausible evidences, charge-sheet has been filed against accused-applicant and co-accused.

Hence, keeping in view the period of custody of applicant as well as the allegations levelled against him, without commenting on merits of this case, grounds for bail are found to be sufficient.

### **ORDER**

Accordingly, bail application is **allowed**. Let accused/applicant **Akash Verma @ Natu** be released on bail in this case on his furnishing a personal bond of **Rs. 25,000/-** alongwith one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of court concerned subject to filing an undertaking so as to abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 480(3) BNSS.
