Instant application, praying for bail under Section 483 BNSS, supported with an affidavit, has been moved on behalf of applicant-accused **Ravindra Kumar @ Chhotu** in Case Crime Number and Sections aforementioned.

In a nutshell, the Prosecution Case is that informant Dileep Kumar Gupta has alleged that he alongwith his family members went to Kanpur and when he returned home on 26.12.2025 at about 20:20 hours, he saw all the articles of the house scattered and some unknown persons steal away essential jewels and cash form his house.

Heard learned counsel for the accused/applicant as well as learned D.G.C (Criminal) for State and perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant is innocent, he has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Applicant is languishing in jail since 10.03.2026. False recovery has been shown from his possession. There is no independent witness of the alleged occurrence. Applicant is a laborer. Applicant undertakes to cooperate in the investigation. Applicant has criminal history of nine other cases in which, he has already been granted bail.

Per-contra, learned DGC (CrI) has submitted that accused/applicant alongwith co-accused persons has committed the theft. Apart from this case, applicant has criminal history of 13 other cases.

It has been alleged that accused/applicant alongwith co-accused persons break into informant's house and steal away essential jewels and cash. Applicant is not named in the FIR. During investigation, acting on a secret information, police apprehended three suspects who disclosed their names as Ravindra Kumar Gautam @ Chhotu, Sunny Rawat @ Kaliya and Shiva Chaurasia alongwith their motorcycle bearing regn. UP32KZ3335 and from the possession of accused/applicant, police recovered essential jewellery of yellow metal and white metal and other articles alongwith Rs. 17,300/-, however, no independent or public witness has been enjoined with the alleged recovery. Applicant is stated to be languishing in jail since 10.03.2026. Alleged offence is triable by Magistrate and entails punishment of less that upto seven years.

Hence, keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances of the case as well as the allegations levelled against accused/applicant, without commenting on merits of this case, grounds for bail are found to be sufficient.

ORDER

Accordingly, bail application is **allowed**. Let accused/applicant **Ravindra Kumar @ Chhotu** be released on bail in this case on his furnishing a personal bond of **Rs. 30,000/-** alongwith one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of court concerned subject to filing an undertaking so as to abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 480(3) BNSS.
