This application praying for bail under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, supported with an affidavit, is moved on behalf of applicant **Santosh Kumar** in Crime Number and Sections aforementioned.

In a nutshell, the prosecution case is that on 05.04.2026 at about 01:30 O'Clock in noon, informant Ram Kishore's daughter Radha Yadav aged about 16 years, was enticed and taken away by Santosh Gautam on his motorcycle. Due to social reputation informant kept searching for his daughter in his relations and came to know that his daughter has been taken away by Santosh at which, informant went to his house and saw his daughter there. He pleaded Santosh and his daughter that his daughter be sent with him but said Santosh called 25-30 persons of his neighbourhood and started threatening to kill informant as well as his daughter. Due to fear informant returned therefrom and narrated about this in his social circle. Informant's mother was so deeply saddened by this that she died on 12.04.2026. His social circle advised him to report about the incident at Police Station.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as learned D.G.C. (Criminal) for State and perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that daughter of informant and the applicant developed love relations. Applicant used to meet informant's daughter and there was no interference of informant in the same. On 21.03.2026, informant's daughter came to applicant's house and said that she would marry applicant and now live with him. Applicant tried to pacify her but she threatened to commit suicide at which, applicant solemnized marriage with informant's daughter on 21.03.2026 and got their marriage registered on 23.03.2026. In the birth-certificate issued by competent authority on 02.03.2026, date of birth of informant's daughter is mentioned as 07.08.2005.

Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opposed bail application and argued that during investigation, plausible evidences are being found against applicant, who enticed informant's daughter for marriage and took her away with him.

Prosecution has alleged against the applicant that he took away minor daughter of informant out of lawful custody of the informant and enticed her for marriage. In the birth certificate of Radha Yadav, issued on 02.3.2025 by Government of UP, Department of Medical and Health, which is filed as enclosure with this bail application, her date of birth is recorded as 07.08.2005. In her statement under Section 183 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, prosecutrix has not supported prosecution version and has stated that she had gone to applicant's house out of her own will and she wants to stay with applicant. No criminal antecedents of applicant are brought on record before this Court. He is languishing in jail since 30.05.2026.

After hearing learned counsels for parties, without commenting on the merits of the Case, grounds for bail are found sufficient and as such, this bail application deserves to be allowed.

ORDER

Bail Application is **allowed** accordingly.

Let the accused/applicant **Santosh Kumar** be released on bail in this Case on his furnishing personal bond of **Rs. 60,000/-** alongwith a surety in like amount to the satisfaction of Court concerned, subject to his filing an undertaking to abide by conditions as enumerated under Section 480 Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.
