This petition came up before me for final hearing on this day in the presence of **Ld. Adv. Mr.R.Sathish**, Advocate for the petitioner/Accused and the **Ld. Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II** appearing for the Respondant/Complainant and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed under Section 480 of BNSS to enlarge the accused on bail for the alleged commission of offences in Crime No.172/2026 u/S.303(2), 326(a) of BNS.

2. Heard. All relevant records perused.
3. The contention of the prosecution is that the investigation is still pending, and thus, if the accused is released on bail, law and order issue may arise. Hence, this petition to be dismissed.
4. At the outset, this Court would proceed to express its opinion that the gravity of the offence, standing by itself would justify the dismissal of the present petition, and no amount of previous good conduct might affect the gravity of the offence. However, upon considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner/accused, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused on the following conditions.
5.
 - a) The petitioner/accused is ordered to be released on bail upon him executing a **bond** for a sum of **Rs.10,000/-, with Two solvent sureties like sum;**
 - b) The sureties shall affix their photographs (which is not older than '6' months before the date of submission) and left thumb impression in the surety bond and shall furnish a copy of their Aadhaar Card or Bank pass book to ensure their identity and access the solvency of the sureties;
 - c) The petitioner/accused shall stay at Sholinghur and appear before the respondent police station daily at 10.30 AM and 05.30 PM, until further orders;
 - d) The petitioner/accused shall provide his residential address, to the respondent police, and, in change of the residential address the same shall be intimated to the respondent police;
 - e) The petitioner/accused shall provide two of his photographs (which is not older than '6' months before the date of submission) along with copies of the identification proofs to the respondent police;

- f) The petitioner/accused shall cooperate with the respondent police, he shall not threaten the witnesses, he shall not tamper the witnesses, and he shall not induce the witnesses;
- g) The petitioner/accused shall appear before this Court on summons;
- h) The petitioner/accused shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required for the purpose of conducting the investigation in the instant case;
- i) The Petitioner shall not involve in any other offence during the period of bail;
- j) This Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner/accused, in accordance with law, on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions and
- k) If the petitioner/accused thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R. shall be registered under Section 229-A of IPC [Sec. 269 BNS, 2023]

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
