Sessions Case No. 15/2025

State of U.P. vs. Amar Singh and Ors.

**U/S 103(1) /3(5), 115(2) /3(5), 117(2) /3(5),
118(1) /3(5), 351(3), 352 BNS,
P/S Jakhlon, District Lalitpur.**

Charge

I, Alok Kumar Parashar, Sessions Judge, Lalitpur hereby charge you accused-

- 1. Amar Singh** s/o Ramnath Lodhi, aged about 28 years,
- 2. Pran Singh** s/o Ramnath Lodhi, aged about 22 years,
- 3. Ramnaresh** s/o Raghuveer Lodhi, aged about 19 years,
- 4. Ramlakhan** s/o Raghuveer Lodhi, aged about 26 years,

all r/o village Nayaganw, Police Station Jakhlon, District Lalitpur as follows:-

- 1.** That you, the accused persons, on or about 14.09.2024, around 02.00 AM, near the house of informant Smt. Susheela, at village Nayaganw, Police Station Jakhlon, District Lalitpur, in furtherance of common intention, assaulted Rupan s/o Bhairo on his head with a shovel, resulting in his death on 30.09.2024. Thereby, you accused persons committed murder by intentionally causing the death of Rupan s/o Bhairo and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 103(1) read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.
- 2.** That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, voluntarily caused hurt to Santosh, Rupam, Sushila and Meghraj and you thereby committed such an offence which is punishable under Section 115(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.
- 3.** That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused, voluntarily caused grievous hurt to Rupan by causing him fracture to his head and to Meghraj by causing him fracture to his fingers and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 117(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.
- 4.** That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, voluntarily caused hurt to Rupan causing the wound by means of a dangerous weapon, namely, a shovel and you thereby committed such an offence which is punishable under Section 118(1) read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.
- 5.** That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, committed criminal intimidation by threatening informant Smt. Sushila and her family members with life and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 351(3) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.
- 6.** That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, intentionally insulted informant Smt. Sushila and her family members by abusing them and thereby gave them provocation intending or knowing it to be likely that such provocation will cause them to break public peace (or to commit any other

offence) and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 352 of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita which is within the cognizance of this Court.

Contents of charge read over and explained to Amar Singh, Pran Singh, Ramnaresh and Ramlakhan in vernacular to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

Case called out. Accused Amar Singh, Pran Singh, Ramnaresh and Ramlakhan appeared before the Court in custody.

Today, case is fixed for hearing on charge.

Heard learned counsel for the accused persons and learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) on framing of charge, and perused the records.

The counsel for the accused persons argued that there is no basis for framing the charges against the accused persons. Hence he prayed for discharge them. In reply, learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) argued that the accused persons came verbally abusing to informant's husband Santosh and when Santosh and Rupan objected to their behaviour, accused persons intentionally attacked Santosh and Rupan. They inflicted a fatal blow to Rupan's head with a shovel, resulting in his death. When the informant Smt. Sushila tried to intervene and rescue them, accused persons also physically assaulted her. They also threatened them with life. Hence, there is sufficient basis for framing of charges against the accused persons.

On the basis of prosecution evidence available on record, this Court is of the considered view that *prima facie* case under Sections 103(1) /3(5), 115(2) /3(5), 117(2) /3(5), 118(1) /3(5), 351(3), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita is made out against accused Amar Singh, Pran Singh, Ramnaresh and Ramlakhan.

Hence, charges under Sections 103(1) /3(5), 115(2) /3(5), 117(2) /3(5), 118(1) /3(5), 351(3), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita are to be framed against accused Amar Singh, Pran Singh, Ramnaresh and Ramlakhan on a separate sheet.
