I am polytechnic in Auto Mechanical. I have produced on record Shop Act License to show my auto workshop. The license obtained by me in the year 2021. The shop where my workshop was situated, owned by Nitin Rupnawar. I have copy of rent agreement. It is not filed on record. I am ready to produce the agreement. I have no rent receipts. No machine is required for repairing the vehicles, I had tools like spanner, rachet, oil filter, impact machine, crowfoot etc. I have no receipts of purchasing such tools. Two persons were there in my workshop as employees/helper. I have no documents to show the account of salary of employees. I am not income tax payer. No TDS case belongs to me was there. No pan card of my business.

In the relevant period of accident my scooter was indemnified with valid insurance policy issued by ICICI Lombard and I am ready to produce it.

At the time of accident my leg came under rear wheel of the tanker. It is true that the truck went ahead me up to 90% before accident while overtaking. On the spot of accident there was no traffic signal. There was traffic at the time of accident. It is not true that I tried to overtake the truck and dashed to its middle portion and came under the rear wheel.

It is not true that I am deposing false that I spent amount of Rs.5 Lakh for treatment and suffered permanent disability due to the amputation and by losing eyesight. I am going to examine the

medical officer for proving the disability. It is not true that I was not earning monthly Rs.50,000/- and claim is false. At the time of accident I was married and I have a son.
