Sessions Case No. 658/2024

State of U.P. vs. Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar

U/S 306, 323, 504, 509 I.P.C.

P/S Kotwali Lalitpur

Charge

I, Alok Kumar Parashar, Sessions Judge, Lalitpur hereby charge you accused Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar s/o Pannalal Ahirwar, r/o village Patora Kalan, Police Station Kotwali Lalitpur, District Lalitpur as follows:-

1. That you, the accused, on or about 21.11.2021, at around 09.30 PM, at village Patora Kalan, Police Station Kotwali Lalitpur, District Lalitpur, abetted Dashrath, the husband of the complainant, to commit suicide, who committed suicide on 22.11.2021 and you thereby committed such offence which is punishable under Section **306** of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court.
2. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused, voluntarily caused hurt to Dashrath and you thereby committed such an offence which is punishable under Section **323** of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court.
3. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused, intentionally insulted Dashrath by verbally abusing him and thereby gave him provocation intending or knowing it to be likely that such provocation will cause him to break public peace (or to commit any other offence) and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section **504** of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court.
4. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused, intending to insult the modesty of the complainant uttered derogatory remarks about the wife of Dashrath and made a demand of an outrageous and unacceptable nature, specifically asking Dashrath to hand over his wife to you and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section **509** of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court.

Contents of charge read over and explained to Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar in vernacular to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

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Case called out. Accused Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar appeared before the Court.

Today, case is fixed for hearing on charge.

Heard learned counsel for the accused and learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) on framing of charge, and perused the records.

The counsel for the accused argued that there is no basis for framing the charges against the accused. Hence he prayed for discharge the accused. In reply, learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) argued that the accused uttered derogatory remarks about the wife of Dashrath and made a demand of an outrageous and unacceptable nature, specifically asking Dashrath to hand over his wife to him. He also assaulted him and abetted him to commit suicide. Tragically, as a result of this extreme provocation and humiliation, Dashrath took his own life by hanging himself. Hence, there is sufficient basis for framing of charges against the accused.

On the basis of prosecution evidence available on record, this Court is of the considered view that *prima facie* case under Sections 306, 323, 504, 509 of the Indian Penal Code is made out against accused Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar.

Hence, charges under Sections **308, 323, 504, 509 of the Indian Penal Code** are to be framed against accused **Arvind @Chhotu Ahirwar** on a separate sheet.
