State of U.P. vs. Imrat & 3 Ors.

U/S 308/34, 323/34, 504, 506 I.P.C.

P/S Jakhlon, District Lalitpur

Charge

I, Narendra Kumar Jha, Sessions Judge, Lalitpur hereby charge you accused-

1. Rajababu s/o Imrat Ahirwar,
2. Imrat Ahirwar s/o Chaude Ahirwar,
3. Chhote Raja Ahirwar s/o Imrat Ahirwar,
4. Pushpendra Ahirwar s/o Imrat Ahirwar,

all r/o village Pipariyavansha, Police Station Jakhlon, District Lalitpur as follows:-

1. That you, the accused persons, on or about 10.05.2024, around 11.30 P.M., at village Pipariyavansha, Police Station Jakhlon, District Lalitpur, in furtherance of common intention, severely assaulted Dileep s/o Natthu with such intention or knowledge that if by that act, you had caused his death, you would have been guilty of culpable homicide not amounting to murder (and that you caused him fracture on left temporal bone of head) and you thereby committed such offence which is punishable under Section 308 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions.
2. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, voluntarily caused hurt to Dileep s/o Natthu and you thereby committed such an offence which is punishable under Section 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions.
3. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, intentionally insulted Dileep s/o Natthu by abusing him and thereby gave him provocation intending or knowing it to be likely that such provocation will cause him to break public peace (or to commit any other offence) and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 504 of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions.
4. That on or about the aforesaid date, time and place, you, the accused persons, committed criminal intimidation by threatening Dileep s/o Natthu with life and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code which is within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions.

Contents of charge read over and explained to Rajababu, Imrat Ahirwar, Chhote Raja Ahirwar and Pushpendra Ahirwar in vernacular to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

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Case called out. Accused Rajababu, Imrat Ahirwar, Chhote Raja Ahirwar and Pushpendra Ahirwar appeared before the Court.

Today, case is fixed for hearing on charge.

Heard learned counsel for the accused persons and learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) on framing of charge, and perused the records.

The counsel for the accused persons argued that there is no basis for framing the charges against the accused persons. Hence he prayed for discharge them. In reply, learned District Government Counsel (Criminal) argued that when the accused persons verbally assaulted Dileep s/o Natthu and he objected, they violently attacked him with wooden sticks, resulting in a severe head wound. The C.T. Scan revealed a fracture on the left temporal bone of the injured Dileep's head, which posed a significant risk to his life. The accused persons also issued life threats.

Hence, there is sufficient basis for framing of charges against the accused persons.

On the basis of prosecution evidence available on record, this Court is of the considered view that *prima facie* case under Sections 308 read with Section 34, 323 read with Section 34, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code is made out against accused Rajababu, Imrat Ahirwar, Chhote Raja Ahirwar and Pushpendra Ahirwar.

Hence, charges under Sections 308 read with Section 34, 323 read with Section 34, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code are to be framed against accused Rajababu, Imrat Ahirwar, Chhote Raja Ahirwar and Pushpendra Ahirwar on a separate sheet.
