CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Babundar and (2) Chanda Devi as follows:-

That you, on 16.02.2016 at about 01.00 A.M. at village Kusarat within the local limits of P.S. Shahganj, District Sonbhadra, and in furtherance of your common intention, committed mischief by fire intending to cause the destruction of house belonging to complainant, which is ordinarily used as a place for the custody of property and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 436 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charge.

Case called out. Accused persons are present on bail along with their learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under section 436 IPC is being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under section 436 IPC. Let charge be framed accordingly.
