ORDER

1. Present application for bail has been moved on behalf of accused applicant Om Prakash Bind @ Bakshi involved in case no. 0174 of 2025, S.C. No. 503 of 2026, for the offence punishable under Section 3/25 of the Arms Act, within the territorial jurisdiction of Police Station Kotwali, District Mau.
2. The brief facts of the case as per FIR are that, on 03.06.2025, in the night at 23.55 O'clock, near Sikatiya Flyover, within the territorial jurisdiction of Police Kotwali, District Mau, a posse comitatus headed by Sub-Inspector of Police Subhash Chandra, raided the accused applicant and from his possession, one piece country made pistol 12 bore along with one piece live cartridge 12 bore as well as looted ornaments were recovered. Recovery memo of the same was prepared at the spot and coming to the Police Station, FIR has been registered.
3. The learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that accused applicant is innocent; nothing has been recovered from his possession. Fake recovery of country made pistol and its cartridge have been shown by the Police from the possession of the accused applicant. No independent witness is cited to the said recovery. The offence is triable by Ist. Class Magistrate. The accused applicant has been detained in jail since 04.06.2025. He prayed for releasing on on bail.
4. The learned In-charge District Government Counsel (CrI.) opposes the application for bail and submits that from the possession of the accused applicant, one piece country made pistol 12 bore along with one piece live cartridge 12 bore as well as looted ornaments were recovered. The accused

applicant committed grave offence. He prayed for dismissal of bail application.

5. It is allegation on the accused applicant that from the possession of the accused applicant, one piece country made pistol 12 bore along with one piece live cartridge 12 bore as well as looted ornaments were recovered, which is denied by the accused applicant. No independent witness is cited to the said recovery. Charge sheet has been filed. The accused applicant has been detained in jail since 04.06.2025. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, detention period, nature of the offence, without expressing opinion on merits of the case, this Court finds it a fit case for bail.
6. Hence, the application for bail moved by the accused-applicant Om Prakash Bind @ Bakshi is ,hereby, allowed and accused applicant is released on bail on his executing a personal bond of Rs.30,000/- and two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned with the condition that:-
 - 1- He shall cooperate in trial and he will not move unnecessary adjournment application.
 - 2- The accused applicant shall not directly or indirectly make inducement, threat or promise to any person, acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence.
 - 3- The accused applicant shall not leave India without permission of the Court.
