ORDER

1. Present application for bail has been moved on behalf of accused applicants Ajay Yadav and Awadhraj Rajbhar involved in case no. 0020 of 2026, for the offences punishable under Sections 3(5), 310(4), 310(2), 238(b) B.N.S., within the territorial jurisdiction of Police Station Kopaganj, District Mau.
2. The brief facts of the case as per FIR are that, on 13.01.2026, at 5.30 O'clock in the evening, applicants Jitendra Kumar Verma and Baijnath Verma were coming from Pirhwal Turn after locking their jewellery shop. In the way near fertilizer godown near village Tarhiwaon, four miscreants tying their mouth by cloth on two motor cycles came and removed key of bike and at gun point, they snatched ornaments of gold and silver and Rs. 20,000/-. Thereafter, they fled from the spot. On 24.01.2026 a posse comitatus headed by Shri Ravindra Nath Rai, Station Officer of Police Station Kopaganj, District Mau, on the information of sneak, arrested accused persons Sujit Yadav, Ashwani Yadav alias Mohan Yadav, Rahul Chauhan and Amresh Chauhan and from their possession some of the above looted ornaments and rupees were recovered. It is allegation on the accused applicants that they have hatched conspiracy to commit the crime.
3. The learned counsel for the accused--applicants submits that accused applicants are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. Accused applicants are not named in FIR and their names came into light during course of investigation. They were not present at the spot at the time of incident. They were detained in jail in another case bearing case crime no. 355/2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 61(1), 115(2), 351(3) B.N.S. and Section 3(2) S.C.& S.T. Act, Police Station Mohammadabad Gohana, District Mau. No independent witness is cited to the case. Accused applicants have been detained in jail since 13.02.2026. Co--accused persons Anjali Yadav @ Ruchi, Vidya Devi, Ashish Yadav and Shubham Singh have been granted bail by this Court. In the case, investigation has been completed and charge sheet has been filed. He

prayed for releasing them on bail.

4. The learned In-charge District Government Counsel (Crl.) opposes the application for bail and submits that accused applicants have hatched the conspiracy to commit such crime, due to which this offence was occurred. The accused applicants committed grave offence. He prayed for dismissal of bail application.
5. It is alleged against the accused applicants that they have hatched conspiracy to commit such crime. Accused applicants are not named in FIR. In the statement of co-accused persons, their names came into light. Nothing has been recovered from their possession. The accused applicants has been detained in jail since 13.02.2026. Co-accused persons Anjali Yadav @ Ruchi, Vidya Devi, Ashish Yadav and Shubham Singh have been granted bail by this Court. Charge sheet has been filed. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, role of the accused applicants, filing of charge sheet and detention period, without expressing opinion on the merits of the case, this Court finds it a fit case for bail.
6. Hence, application for bail moved by the accused-applicants Ajay Yadav and Awadhraj Rajbhar is ,hereby, allowed and accused applicants are released on bail on each of them executing a personal bond of Rs. 40,000/- and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned on following conditions:-
 - 1-They shall cooperate in trial and they will not move unnecessary adjournment application.
 - 2-The accused applicants shall not directly or indirectly make inducement, threat or promise to any person, acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence.
 - 3-The accused applicants shall not leave India without permission of the Court.
