ORDER

1. The present application for Bail has been moved on behalf of the accused-applicant Kunwar Vipul Pratap Singh @ Shubham Singh involved in case crime no. 0218 of 2026, for the offences punishable under sections 310(4), 310(5) B.N.S, within the territorial jurisdiction of Police Station Ghosi, District Mau.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the accused-applicant as well as learned In-charge District Government Counsel (Crl.) and perused the record.
3. The prosecution story in brief are that on 01.06.2026 at about 2.30 O'clock in the night, in the limit of ahead Asana canal culvert on Gofa Road, within the territorial jurisdiction of Police Station Ghosi, District Mau a posse comitatus headed by Sub-Inspector of Police Avinash Kumar Yadav on the information of sneak, arrested Ashu Yadav, Danish @ Dana, Ankit Pal, Indrajeet Yadav and Shubham Yadav making plan for committing dacoity and from the possession of accused Ashu Yadav, one 32 bore pistol along with one live cartridge 32 bore along with one Oppo A-57 mobile, from the possession of accused Danish alias Dana, one piece One Plus mobile along with one piece country made pistol 315 bore and one piece live cartridge 315 bore, from the possession of accused Ankit Pal, Rs.300/-, one piece plier, one piece screw driver, from the possession of accused Indrajeet Yadav, one piece small torch one long cutter and from the possession of accused Shubham Yadav one piece torch and Rs.400/- were recovered.
4. The learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused applicant is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. Noting has been recovered from his possession. The prosecution story is fake and concocted. From his possession only one small torch and Rs.240/- are said to have been recovered. He has been detained in jail since

01.06.2026. He prayed for releasing him on bail.

5. The learned In-charge District Government Counsel (Crl.) submits that the accused applicant along with co-accused persons were arrested by the Police making place for committing dacoity. From the possession of accused applicant, one small torch and Rs.400/- have been recovered by the Police. The accused applicant has committed grave offence. He prayed for rejection of application for bail.
6. It is allegations on the accused applicant that accused applicant with his associates, was arrested making preparation for committing dacoity and from his possession, one piece small torch and Rs.400/- were recovered. Recovery was denied by the accused applicant. There is no independent witness of said recovery. The accused applicant has been detained in jail since 01.06.2026. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, detention period of the accused applicant and nature of the offence, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court finds it a fit case for bail.
7. Hence, the application for bail moved by the accused-applicant Kunwar Vipul Pratap Singh @ Shubham Singh is ,hereby, allowed and he is released on bail on his executing a personal bond of Rs.30,000/- and two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of Magistrate concerned on the following conditions:-
 - 1- He shall appear before the investigating officer as and when required. He shall also appear before the trial Court on each and every date and shall cooperate with the trial and he will not move unnecessary adjournment application.
 - 2- The accused applicant shall not directly or indirectly make inducement, threat or promise to any person, acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence.
 - 3- The accused applicant shall not leave India without permission of the Court.
