Vide order no. Judl.II/F.102/South/Saket/2026/24431-24461 New Delhi dated 29.05.2026 issued by Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge (South), this court has been authorised u/s 8(8) of the BNSS to dispose of bail / urgent applications pertaining to the police stations / investigating agencies as mentioned in the said order.

This is an application u/s 482 BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail moved on behalf of accused M. Radha

Part arguments heard.

During the course of arguments, another counsel Sh. Harbans Singh, who appeared in another matter before this Court stated at bar that as per his knowledge atleast 22 cases are registered against the present applicant and her husband by Delhi Police. However, neither the IO has reflected the same in his reply nor the applicant in her bail application has mentioned the same. As per IO, only 06 cases have been traced by him to be registered against the applicant. Further, during the course of submissions, IO submits that investigation is complete and he is going to file the chargesheet and has not sought the custody of the accused whereas, in his reply he has stated that the investigation is still going on.

Under these circumstances, **issue notice to the DCP concerned to depute a competent IO in this case to file a detailed status report and the list of all the cases registered against the present applicant**, since it has been submitted by a different counsel present before the Court that the applicant is a habitual offender who has cheated so many persons but for the reasons best known to the IO, the same has not been reflected in the reply nor before the Court.
