ORDER

- 1) Petition filed under Order 22 Rule 4 of CPC to implead the

legal heirs of 4th defendant.

2) The respondents remained *exparte* in this petition.

3) The petitioners are the plaintiffs in the suit. The petitioners have filed the suit for permanent injunction against the respondents.
