

State Vs. Lakhwinder Singh

Heard on the application for releasing the vehicle on sapurdari to the applicant. Report of the concerned police station received, wherein it is submitted that in abovesaid FIR, **one Swaraj Tractor bearing registration No. PB19E-1395 alongwith trolly were taken into police possession in the said FIR and it was further reported that as per RC, said vehicle belongs to Lakhwinder Singh son of Sukhmander Singh, resident of Seehan Patti, Budhlada and the police authorities have no objection if the same is given on sapurdari to said applicant.**

The present application has been filed by abovesaid applicant and she has produced on record the copy of RC. He is the original owner of the above said vehicle.

As such, keeping in view the report of the police, photocopy of RC, no other claimant has staked his claim over the said vehicle, as such the abovesaid vehicle, is ordered to be released on sapurdari to the applicant, subject to furnishing sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/-(rupees five lacs only) with one surety in the like amount with conditions

1. That applicant shall produce the vehicle in question on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail, failing which his personal and surety bonds shall be cancelled and forfeited to the State without notice;
- 2 The applicant shall not sell, alienate, dispose of the vehicle in question or any part thereof in any manner, till disposal of the case except with the prior permission of the court;

- 3 The applicant shall not change the make or any part thereof till disposal of the case.

The requisite bonds furnished by the applicant which are accepted and attested. Release warrant be issued as per rules. SHO/IO is directed to get clicked the photographs of the above said vehicle in question from all angles, so that its identification is fully established and get the same attested from the applicant. Copy of this order be forwarded to SHO for its compliance. Photographs so taken be placed on record with challan.
