Commitment order.

1. Vide challan dated 14.12.2018, accused Lakhvir Singh @ Vicky son of Gurmukh Singh has been sent in custody for trial under Sections 363, 366 IPC & Sections 4, 8, 12 POCSO Act by SHO, Police Station Samrala District, Ludhiana.
2. The prosecution version is that on 26.07.2018, complainant Jaipal Singh along with his family members was sleeping on the top of the house. When complainant woke-up at about 4:00 AM, he found his daughter Harmanpreet Kaur missing. He tried to search his daughter with his own ways and thereafter he came to know that his daughter has been taken away by Lakhvir Singh @ Vicky son of Gurmukh Singh r/o village Rohle PS Samrala, District Ludhiana forcefully at the assurance of marrying her. Statement of complainant was recorded. FIR was registered. Accused was arrested. His personal search was conducted. Statement under Section 175 Cr.P.C. was recorded. Form 25-35-1A was filled. Statements of witnesses under Section 161 Cr.P.C. were recorded. Photographs were clicked. Special reports were sent. On completion of the investigation, the challan has been presented.

3. On presentation of the challan, copies of the challan along with supporting documents were supplied to the accused free of costs as per the provisions of Section 208 Cr.P.C.
4. I have heard Ld. APP for the State and have carefully gone through the record on the file.
5. There is prima-facie sufficient evidence to proceed against the accused under Sections 363, 366 IPC and Sections 4, 8, 12 of POCSO Act. The offence punishable under Sections 4, 8 & 12 of POCSO Act are triable exclusively by the Court of Sessions, the instant case stands committed to the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Ludhiana for further proceedings, for 16.01.2019. The accused, who is in custody in this case, is directed to be produced before the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on the date fixed at 10.00 AM sharp. Assistant Public Prosecutor be notified regarding the commitment. Ahlmad is directed to send the file to the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, complete in all respects, well before the date fixed.
