Police report received. As per report submitted by the police, no purpose will be served by keeping the vehicle in question in the custody of police and they have no objection if the present application is allowed and the said vehicle in question is released on sapurdari to sapurdar.

Arguments heard, keeping in view the report of police, vehicle in question i.e. Motor-cycle Hero Splendor bearing registration no. PB-02-CE-5734 is ordered to be released to the applicant on furnishing of sapurdari bonds to the tune of ₹ 80,000/- with one surety of like amount subject to following conditions:-

1. Sapurdar will not change the physical condition of above said vehicle.
2. Shall not sell the same.
3. Will produce the same on each and every date of hearing till the pendency of the case.
4. Concerned SHO is directed to take photographs of above said vehicle and prepare inventory, prior to release of the aforementioned articles.
5. Before handing over the vehicle in question, proper receipt of issue of the vehicle be taken from the applicant.
6. Concerned SHO is directed to take the photographs, negative or CD and to prepare the inventory of vehicle in question and same be placed on record by Investigating Officer on the next date.

7. Copy of this order be sent to the concerned SHO for compliance.
8. Ahlmad is directed to attached the papers with the main file.
