

Complainant present. The complainant presented the complaint on this day under Section 200 Cr.P.C for the offence punishable u/s 138 of NI Act. The complainant files an affidavit as a Sworn statement as per decision reported in (2014) 5 SC Cases 590 in the case of Indian Bank Association and others Vs Union of India and others and ILR 2014 Kar 5237 M/s Mesh Trans Gears Pvt Ltd. Vs Dr.R.Parvatha Reddhy, the affidavit filed by the complainant is treated as Sworn Statement Exhibits are marked.

Heard counsel for complainant. Perused the documents, affidavit. It appears the complainant prima facie made out case against accused Under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. The complainant complied the provision of 138(a) to (c) of NI Act. It also appears the cheque has been issued towards discharge of Legally Enforceable Debt or other liability. There is no delay. Witness list also filed. Hence, there are sufficient material at this stage to issue process against accused accordingly following:
