

Bajaj Finance Vs. Ranjan Kumar (COMA No.10437/16)

Non-bailable warrants issued against the accused not received back. Perusal of the file shows that despite the issuance of summons through ordinary process, through bailable warrants or through non bailable warrants the accused has failed to put in his appearance. Counsel for the complainant stated at bar that the accused had been intentionally avoiding the service of process upon him. In view of above circumstances this court is satisfied that further coercive methods need to be adopted for procuring the presence of the accused. Accused be now served through proclamation U/S 82 Cr.p.c by way of publication to be published in the newspaper "**Uttam Hindu**" on depositing of the publication charges within 5 days. Ahlmad is directed to issue publication for 03.11.2017.
