The applicant/accused Pran Verma had filed an application seeking permission to travel abroad to USA for a period of seven months from 10.05.2026 to 10.12.2026 due to medical exigencies of his wife. It is submitted that vide order dated 30.04.2026, the travel application of the applicant was allowed but the period of travel was recorded as six months instead of seven

months and hence, the present application is filed seeking limited modification of the order dated 30.04.2026 to the extent that the period of “six months” be read as “seven months” or in the alternative the dates may be mentioned from 10.05.2026 to 10.12.2026.

The application has not been opposed by Ld. PP for the CBI submitting that the travel application has already been allowed and appropriate order may be passed on present application.

I have perused the record in the light of the submissions made before me.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the modification application of applicant Pran Verma is allowed. The order stands modified to the extent that the travel permission is extended till seven months instead of six months from 10.05.2026 to 10.12.2026. The other terms and conditions of the order dated 30.04.2026 shall remain the same.

The application stands disposed off accordingly.
