Heard the Learned Counsel for the Defence as well as the Learned D.G.C.(Crl.) for the State. Five accused namely Irfan alias Tulla,Mohd.Taufeeq,Irfan,Salman and Raju are named in the first information report wherein accused Raju has been declared juvenile, hence his case has been separated and accused Irfan alias Tulla,Mohd.Taufeeq,Irfan and Salman are present in person before the court.

The learned prosecutor has opened his case by describing the charges brought against the accused and stating by what evidence he proposes to prove the guilt of the accused.

After considering, and also going through the documents, as relied upon by the prosecution, I find that there is ground for presuming that the accused have committed offence punishable under section 304 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and therefore, Charge be framed against the accused.
