

In the Court of Sessions Judge, Ramabai Nagar (Kanpur Dehat)**Anticipatory Bail Application No. 519/2026****CNR No.- UPRN010013152026**

Order

1. This anticipatory bail application is on behalf of accused persons/applicant **Rambabu & Mohan Devi @ Mohan Dei** both resident of Village-Pachganwa, Post Vishayakpur, P.S Rania, District Kanpur Dehat, in Case Crime No. 28/2026 U/ss: 80(2), 85 BNS & ¾ D.P. Act P.S Rania, District Kanpur Dehat.

2. Briefly the prosecution case is that the informant/complainant Dharmendra Singh S/o Dhara Singh R/o Achal Talab Pannaganj, P.S Gandhipark District Aligarh registered an F.I.R that his sister Mamta was married on 18.02.2022 with Pawan Singh in which sufficient endowment was given as per his capacity. After the marriage, husband Pawan Singh, father-in-law Ram Babu & mother-in-law Mohan Devi started demanding motorcycle as additional dowry and started harassing her for dowry. Accused persons left his sister at her parental house and on assurance of fulfilling their demand they took her back. On 10.02.2026 at about 06:00 P.M Rajesh called him and informed about murder of his sister. On the information complainant called his brother-in-law Pawan Singh, who told him that Mamta has hanged herself. Complainant along-with his family member went to Mamta's in-law's house and got information that dead-body was kept in post-mortem house Akbarpur. Accused persons killed his sister due to non fulfillment of demand of dowry. Mamta was killed by her husband Pawan Singh, father-in-law Rambabu & mother-in-law Mohan Devi for demand of dowry.

3. The counsel for the applicant/accused argued that the allegation are false and fabricated. They has been falsely implicated in this case. They are innocent. Marriage

was performed without any demand of dowry. All the allegation are false, no documents/complaint regarding demand of dowry is made. Deceased was short tempered lady. On the fateful day of incident, the deceased was insisting to go to Delhi to attend the wedding of her relative. As the husband refused, due to this reason she got annoyed and committed suicide by hanging her self. This false FIR was lodged to make pressure to extract money.

4. On behalf of the prosecution, the learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opposed the anticipatory bail and argued that the accused persons, demanded motorcycle as additional dowry. When the demand of additional dowry was not fulfilled, they subjected her to physical and mental harassment. Deceased died within four years of marriage. The alleged offence of dowry death is serious in nature, accordingly prayed to reject the anticipatory bail.

5. I have heard arguments of Ld. Counsel for the accused and Ld. D.G.C (Cri.) and Ld. Counsel of complainant and perused the case diary and other relevant prosecution papers.

6. From the perusal of the prosecution papers, it is clear that informant and other family members of deceased has alleged that the accused persons, demanded motorcycle as additional dowry from the deceased. When the demand was not fulfilled the deceased was physically and mentally harassed. In post-mortem report, a ligature mark was found on the neck of the deceased, indicating that the death occurred due to hanging. Cause of death was mentioned "Asphyxia due to antemortem hanging". Investigation is still pending. The alleged offence is serious in nature. Accused persons are father-in-law & mother-in-law of deceased.

7. Therefore, considering all the above facts and circumstances of the case, and without going into the merits of the case, and keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, there is no sufficient ground to release the accused persons on anticipatory bail.

8. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application of the applicants/accused persons is rejected.
