This suit has come up for final hearing before this court on 12.02.2026, in the presence of Thiru. M. Singaram, Advocate for the Plaintiff and Thiru. K. Balachandhar, Advocate for the 1st defendant and Thiru. K. Karthikeyan, Government Pleader for the 2nd defendant both parties present compromise petition filed and allowed and upon perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court hereby delivered the following. . .

JUDGMENT

1. The suit is filed by the plaintiff to declare that the marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant were dissolved by Khula dated 26.02.2022 as per Muslim Law and for mandatory injunction to cancel the Marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant registered before Adhirampattinam, Sub-Registrar Office dated 06.07.2021 and other appropriate relief with cost.

2. Brief facts of the plaint:

The marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant was solemnized on 24.03.2021 at Sekadi School, Adirampattinam, in the presence of relatives, friends, and parents, with their consent. No children were born out of the said wedlock.

After the marriage, misunderstandings and disputes arose between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant, and they started living separately. Though several attempts were made by the parents and relatives of both parties to reconcile and reunite them, no fruitful result was achieved. Therefore, a petition was submitted before the Shamsul Islam Sangam, Adirampattinam. The members of the said Sangam conducted several meetings with both parties and held discussions; however, the parties did not resume cohabitation.

Subsequently, on 22.02.2022, the 1st defendant submitted a petition before the said Sangam. Based on the advice of Islamic Ulemas, the Sangam passed a final resolution dissolving the Nikah (marriage) solemnized on 24.03.2021 and issued a letter dated 26.02.2022 to the plaintiff. Thus, the marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant stands dissolved in accordance with Islamic law.

The marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant was registered on 06.07.2021 at the Sub-Registrar Office, Adirampattinam, as Document No.128 of 2021. Though the marriage has been dissolved in accordance with Islamic law, the subsisting registration of marriage continues to remain on record, which poses an obstacle for the plaintiff to lead her future life peacefully.

Hence, the present suit has been filed seeking a declaration that the marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant stands dissolved in accordance with Islamic law and for consequential relief.

3. In support of the plaintiff's case, no witnesses were examined and no documents were marked. On the side of the defendants also, no witnesses were examined and no documents were marked.

4. After the filing of the suit, summons was issued to the defendants on 08.10.2025. The 1st defendant appeared and filed a written statement on 06.02.2026 admitting the case of the plaintiff.
5. On a perusal of the pleadings and available records, and in view of the admission made by the 1st defendant, this Court finds that the marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant was dissolved in accordance with Islamic law pursuant to the proceedings before the Shamsul Islam Sangam, Adirampattinam, on 22.02.2022, followed by the letter dated 26.02.2022.

Accordingly, it is declared that the Nikah (marriage) between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant, solemnized on 24.03.2021, stands dissolved in accordance with Islamic law. The 2nd defendant is directed to cancel the registration of marriage between the plaintiff and the 1st defendant in accordance with law.

In the result, the suit is decreed without costs.
