Advocate for plaintiff filed memo stating that the application u/o 23 rule 3 of CPC filed on 21-03-2023 may be dismissed as not pressed. Advocate for defendants submits that no objection to allow the said memo.

In view of the memo filed by the plaintiff the compromise petition on 21-03-2023 is dismissed as not pressed.

Advocate for plaintiff filed IA u/o 6 Rule 16 of CPC for deleting of item No. 3 and 9.

Advocate for defendant submits that no objection to allow. Heard and allowed. Accordingly the suit of the plaintiff is dismissed as against the item No. 3 and 9.
