CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Babaloo Kewat, (2) Ramadhin Kewat and (3) Manvasiya as follows :-

Firstly, that you Babaloo kewat being husband of deceased Sugiya, you Ramadhin Kewat, being father-in-law of deceased Sugiya, you Manvasiya, being mother-in-law of deceased Sugiya, subjected Sugiya to cruelty with a view to meet the demand of dowry since the date of marriage and upto the date of death and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 498A I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, between 03.11.2021 and 07.12.2021 at unknown time, at village Sidhawan, within the local limits of P.S. Anpara, District Sonbhadra, and in furtherance of your common intention, did commit murder by intentionally, causing the death of Sugiya and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 302 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date and unknown time, covered the dead body in Charak Pathari's hill to disappear the evidence of the said offence with the intention of screening yourselves from the legal punishment and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 201 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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ORDER

Case called out. Accused persons Babaloo Kewat, Ramadhin Kewat and Manvasiya are present from jail along with their learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charge under sections 498A, 302, 302 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under sections 498A, 302/34, 201 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.
