State Vs. Ramjanam alias Tamman and others

**CHARGE**

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Ramjanam alias Tamman, (2) Jairam Yadav, (3) Ram Prasad Harijan and (4) Dayaram Dusadh as follows :-

Firstly, that you, on 07.01.2021 at about 16:00 hours, near Karmanasa bridge in jungle situated at village Chaukhada, within the local limits of P.S. Raipur, District Sonbhadra, were found transporting 64 animals (ox, cow, calf, heifer) for the purpose of slaughtering from the State of Uttar Pradesh to the State of Bihar without any permit and thereby you committed offence punishable under section 8 read with sections 3 and 5A of the Uttar Pradesh Prevention of Cow Slaughter Act and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, were carrying 64 animals (ox, cow, calf, heifer) for slaughtering and they had fastened in cruel manner with rope, and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 11 Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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**ORDER**

**30.06.2022**

Case called out. Accused persons Ramjanam alias Tamman, Jairam Yadav, Ram Prasad Harijan and Dayaram Dusadh are present on bail along with their learned counsels.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under section 3/5A/8 Prevention of Cow Slaughter Act, and section 11 Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under section 8 read with sections 3 and 5A of the Uttar Pradesh Prevention of Cow Slaughter Act, and section 11 Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act. Let charges be framed accordingly.
