State Versus Manish alias Ankit and others.

CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Manish alias Ankit, (2) Sumit Kumar and (3) Amit as follows :-

Firstly that you, on 21.03.2021, at about 11:00 PM, at village Bachara, within the local limits of P.S. Babhani, District Sonbhadra, in furtherance of your common intention, voluntarily caused hurt to Ramsarish Yadav, and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 323 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, in furtherance of your common intention, grievous hurt to Ramsarish Yadav and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 325 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, committed criminal intimidation by threatening Ramsarish Yadav, to kill and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 506 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Lastly, that you, on the said date, time and place, in furtherance of your common intention, caused injury on the body of Ramsarish Yadav and during treatment Ramsarish Yadav died on 24.03.2021 at Trauma Center, IMS, BHU, Varanasi and that you committed culpable homicide not amounting to murder, causing the death of Ramsarish Yadav and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 304 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Case called Out. Accused persons Manish alias Ankit, Sumit Kumar and Amit are present on bail along with their learned counsel.

Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under sections 323, 325, 506, 304 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there are nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under sections 323 read with section 34, 325 read with section 34, 304 read with section 34, 506 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.
