Petition is filed under Section 166 (1) (A) of The Motor
Vehicles Act, 1988, claiming compensation of Rs.3,00,000/-
(Rupees three lakhs only) with interest and costs against the
respondents No.1 to 6(added as per orders passed in I.A.
No.913/2023 dated 06-11-2024).

Petition presented on 26-12-2020 and numbered on 06-01-2021.

Compensation claimed at Rs.3,00,000/- and Court fee of
Rs.2,360/- is paid under Section 475(1) of A.P.M.V. Rules.

This petition came on 14-07-2026 for final hearing before me in
the presence of Sri M.L.Srinivasa Reddy, Sri M.Anudeep Reddy and Sri
D.Madhusudhana Rao, Sri G.Venkateswarlu and Sri J.Krishna,
Advocates for the petitioner and Sri L.Hari Hara Natha Reddy, Advocate
for the respondents No.2, Sri P.Ramanjaneyulu, Advocate for the
respondent No.5 and respondent No.1,3,4 and 6 remained exparte, this
Tribunal **doth order and decreetal order** as follows:-

1. That, the petition be and the same is hereby allowed in part,
awarding compensation of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty
thousand only)** towards compensation to the petitioner.

2. That, the petitioner be and is hereby entitled to interest at 7.5% per annum on the amount awarded from the date of petition till the date of deposit.
3. That, respondents 1 to 3 be and are hereby jointly and severally liable to pay the above awarded compensation amount to the petitioner.
4. That, the respondents 1 to 3 be and are hereby directed to deposit the above amount awarded within a period of one month from the date of this order, failing which, they are liable to pay the penal interest at 9% per annum.
5. That, the petitioner, who is the injured be and is hereby entitled for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) which shall be deposited to his account directly or in the account of father of petitioner, who is natural guardian, out of the awarded amount along with accrued interest and costs and on deposit the father of minor petitioner be and is hereby permitted to withdraw the entire amount.
6. That, the petitioner be and is hereby not entitled to any interest for the period where the petition was dismissed for default and till it was restored, if any.
7. That, the rest of the claim of the petitioner be and is hereby dismissed.
8. That, Advocate's fee is fixed at Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only).
9. That, the case against R4 to R6 be and is hereby dismissed.
10. That, respondent No.1 to 3 do also pay an amount of **Rs.3,557/- (Rupees three thousand five hundred and fifty seven only)** being the proportionate costs of the petition to the petitioner.
11. That, second respondent do bear its own costs of **Rs.3,102/-** .
