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CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Abhay Prakash Yadav as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 04.09.2019, at unknown time, at L-41 Hindalco Colony, within the circle of P.S. Pipari, District Sonbhadra, voluntarily caused hurt to complainant and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 323 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, intentionally insulted and thereby gave provocation to complainant, intending that such provocation will cause the said person to break the public peace and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 504 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you on 02.01.2020, at unknown time, committed criminal intimidation by threatening, to kill on phone and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 506 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Fourthly, that you, on 26.10.2019, at unknown time, did sexual contact and made sexually coloured remark to complainant in market and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 354-A(3) I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Fifthly, that you, prior to 26.10.2019, at unknown time, at Gautam Lodge, committed rape on the complainant against her will and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 376 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Lastly, that you, on 02.01.2020, at unknown time and place, published or transmitted the picture of complainant in the electronic form which contains sexually explicit act and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 67A IT Act and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused and submitted that charges under sections 323, 504, 506, 354A(3), 376 IPC & section 67A IT Act are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused actually committed any crime and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused has committed offence punishable under sections 323, 504, 506, 354A(3), 376 IPC & section 67A IT Act. Let charges be framed accordingly.
