ORDER

Case called out. Present accused Jaishankar Rauniyar on bail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned in-charge D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charge under sections 306 IPC is being made.

Learned counsel for the accused submitted that there was no argument on the part of the accused and suicide was the sole decision of the deceased and therefore accused be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused has committed offence punishable under section 306 IPC. Let charge be framed accordingly.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charge.
