CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Jairam as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 25.12.2022 at about 4:30 pm at Village Parsoi Tola Semadah, within the local limits of P.S. Obra, District Sonbhadra, kidnapped complainant's daughter Fulwanti a minor girl aged about 14 years, from lawful guardianship of her parents and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 363 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, kidnapped complainant's daughter Fulwanti, with intent that she may be compelled to marry against her will or in order that she may be forced to illicit intercourse and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 366 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Case called out. Accused Jairam is present on bail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on charge.

Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charges under sections 363, 366 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused actually committed any crime and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused has committed offence punishable under sections 363, 366 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.
