CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Smt. Panpati Devi as follows:-

That you, on 07.04.2023, at about 10:00 PM, at village Dhankhor, within the local limits of P.S. Myorpur, District Sonbhadra, caused injury on the head of Ramavatar and that you committed culpable homicide not amounting to murder, causing the death of Ramavatar and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 304 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charge.

Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charge under section 304 IPC is being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused person actually committed any crime and therefore she may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsels, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that the accused person has committed offence punishable under section 304 IPC. Let charge be framed accordingly.
