**CHARGE**

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Deepak Kumar Panika alias Deepak Panika and (2) Md. Naushad Siddqui alias Rehan as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 28.06.2022 at 05:45 hours, at Murdhawa Tiraha, within the local limits of P.S. Pipari, District Sonbhadra, dishonestly received stolen property, to wit Motorcycle No. JH01BA 2315 knowing or having reason to believe the same to be stolen property and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 411 IPC and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, were a habitual receiver or dealer in property which you knew to be stolen property and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 413 I.P.C and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, voluntarily assisted in concealing property to wit, Motorcycle which you knew to be stolen property and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 414 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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**ORDER**

Case called out. Accused persons are present from jail along with their learned counsels.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under sections 41, 411, 413, 414 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsels for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under sections 411, 413, 414 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.

Fix 22.12.2022 for prosecution evidence.

This case is transferred to the court of Addl. Sessions Judge, Court No. 1, Sonbhadra for trial according to law.
