CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Doli, (2) Veenita and (3) Bachcha as follows :-

Firstly, that you, on 01.09.2019, at about 09:30 hours, at Vikas Nagar Kanjad Basti, town Robertsganj, within the local limits of P.S. Robertsganj, District Sonbhadra, were found having possession of spurious and noxious liquor, urea and ammonium chloride (Nausadar) and was intending to sell such article as drink and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 272 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, offered for sale as drink the said spurious and noxious liquor knowing or having reason to believe that the same is noxious as drink and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 273 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, were found in possession of two jerry-can of 20 liters and one jerry-can of 10 liters filled with spurious liquor and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 60 Excise Act and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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ORDER

Case called out. Accused persons are present on bail along with their learned counsels.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under sections 272, 273 IPC and 60 Excise Act are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsels for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime, and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that the accused persons have committed offence punishable under sections 272, 273 IPC and 60 Excise Act. Let charges be framed accordingly.
