CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Amit Kumar Kanjad as follow :-

Firstly, that you along with other persons, on 03.03.2021 at 08:00 hour at village Kanjad Basti, Robertsganj, within the local circle of P.S. Robertsganj, District Sonbhadra, were found having possession of spurious and noxious liquor, 100g urea and 100g ammonium chloride (Nausadar) and was intending to sell such article as drink and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 272 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you along with other persons, on the said date, time and place, offered for sell as drink the said spurious and noxious liquor knowing or having reason to believe that the same is noxious as drink and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 273 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you along with other persons, on the said date, time and place, were found in possession of one jerry-can of ten liters filled with spurious liquor and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 60 (1) Excise Act and within the cognizance of this court.

Fourthly, that you along with other persons, on the said date, time and place, were found making liquor in contravention of valid license or permit and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 60 (2) Excise Act and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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ORDER

Case called out. Accused Amit Kumar Kanjad on bail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charges under sections 272, 273 IPC and 60(1) & 60(2) Excise Act are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused actually committed any crime and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused has committed offence punishable under sections 272, 273 IPC and 60(1) & 60(2) Excise Act. Let charges be framed accordingly.
