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CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Nabihul Hasan alias Nawab as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 13.06.2022, at about 06:30 AM, at complainant's house situated at New Market, Turra, within the local limits of P.S. Pipari, District Sonbhadra, committed house trespass by entering into a building belonging to complainant used as a human dwelling, having made preparation for causing hurt to Ajay Pandey, and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 452 I.P.C. and within my cognizance.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, and, voluntarily caused hurt to Ajay Pandey by knife, and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 324 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, and, inflicted knife blow on the body of Ajay Pandey with such intention and under such circumstances, that if by that act you had caused the death of Ajay Pandey, you would have been guilty of murder and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 307 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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ORDER

Case called out. Accused Nabihul Hasan alias Nawab is present from jail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused and submitted that charges under sections 452, 324, 307 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused actually committed any crime and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused has committed offence punishable under sections 452, 324, 307 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.

Fix 07.10.2022 for prosecution evidence. Issue summon to witness Sanjay Pandey.

This case is transferred to the court of Addl. Sessions Judge/F.T.C. (CAW), Sonbhadra for disposal according to law.
