CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Rakesh Maurya and (2) Krishnawati as follows:-

Firstly, that you, prior to 26.03.2023 at unknown time, at village Patehara, within the local limits of P.S. Karma, District Sonbhadra, committed criminal intimidation by threatening Urmila to kill and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 506 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, abetted deceased Urmila to commit suicide prior to 26.03.2022 at unknown time, at village Patehara, PS Karma, and the deceased Urmila committed suicide between 26.03.2022 and 30.03.2022, at unknown time, at village Patehara, within the local limits of P.S. Karma, District Sonbhadra and thereby you committed an offence punishable under section 306 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Case called out. Accused persons are present on bail along with their learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charge under sections 306, 506 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime, and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that the accused persons has committed offence punishable under sections 306 read with section 34, 506 IPC. Let the charge be framed accordingly.
