CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Vikas Harijan as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 10.07.2023, at unknown time, at Government Girls Inter College, situated at Robertsganj, within the local limits of P.S. Robertsganj, District Sonbhadra, kidnapped complainant's daughter Aarti a minor girl aged about 17 years 6 months, from lawful guardianship of her parents and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 363 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, kidnapped complainant's daughter Aarti, with intent that she may be compelled to marry against her will or in order that she may be forced to illicit intercourse and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 366 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charges under sections 363, 366 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused actually committed any crime, and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that the accused has committed offence punishable under sections 363, 366 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.

Fix 30.10.2023 for prosecution evidence.

This case is transferred to the court of Addl. Sessions Judge/F.T.C. (CAW), Sonbhadra for disposal according to law.
