**CHARGE**

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Ramdhani as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 07.07.2023, at about 02:30 AM, at complainant's house situated at village Chakbagadari Sani, within the local limits of P.S. Babhani, District Sonbhadra, committed house trespass by entering into a building belonging to complainant used as a human dwelling, having made preparation for causing hurt to family member of complainant Raghuveer, and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 452 I.P.C. and within my cognizance.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, voluntarily caused grievous hurt to Raghuveer by sharp object and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 326 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, inflicted axe blow on the body of Raghuveer with such intention and under such circumstances, that if by that act you had caused the death of Raghuveer, you would have been guilty of murder and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 307 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

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**ORDER**

Case called out. Accused Ramdhani is present from jail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charges under sections 452, 326, 307 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused person submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused person actually committed any crime, and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsels, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is sufficient ground for presuming that accused person has committed offence punishable under sections 452, 326, 307 IPC. Let charge be framed accordingly.
