CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you Vijay Kumar Shahani as follows:-

Firstly, that you, on 10.10.2018 at about 08:00 PM, at Quarter No. H-3/10 ABCIL, Colony Kanaudiya, Renukoot, within the local limits of P.S. Pipari, District Sonbhadra, committed the theft of vehicle no. UP64AD 6023 HF Delux and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 379 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, dishonestly received stolen property, i.e. above vehicle knowing or having reason to believe the same to be stolen property and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 411 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Thirdly, that you, on the said date, time and place, were a habitual receiver or dealer in property, which you knew to be stolen property and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 413 I.P.C and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Case called out. Accused persons Vijay Kumar Shahani is present on bail along with his learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused person and submitted that charges under sections 379, 411, 413 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused person submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused person actually committed any crime and therefore he may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused person has committed offence punishable under sections 379, 411, 413 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.

Fix 23.09.2022 for prosecution evidence. Issue summon to witness Rajendra Kumar.

This case is transferred to the court of Addl. Sessions Judge/F.T.C. (CAW), Sonbhadra for disposal according to law.
