CHARGE

I, Ashok Kumar Yadav-I, Sessions Judge, Sonbhadra do hereby charge you (1) Dasrath, (2) Pankaj, (3) Dheeraj and (4) Uday as follows :-

Firstly, that you, on 10.10.2019 at about 07:00 p.m. at village Sahijan Kala, within the local limits of P.S. Robertsganj, District Sonbhadra, and in furtherance of your common intention, voluntarily caused grievous hurt to Chandan Singh and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 325 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Secondly, that you, on the said date, time and place, and, in furtherance of your common intention, caused injury on the body of Chandan Singh, with such intention and under such circumstances, that if by that you had caused the death of Chandan Singh you would have been guilty of culpable homicide not amounting to murder and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 308 read with section 34 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

Lastly, that you, on the said date, time and place, committed criminal intimidation by threatening Chandan Singh to kill and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 506 I.P.C. and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this court on the said charges.

Case called out. Accused persons are present on bail along with their learned counsel.

Heard on framing of charge. Learned D.G.C. (Criminal) opened the case and briefly submitted about the evidence and material collected against the accused persons and submitted that charges under sections 325, 308, 506 IPC are being made out.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused persons submitted that there is nothing on record to suggest that the accused persons actually committed any crime and therefore they may be discharged.

Upon consideration of documents available on record and after hearing the submissions of the learned counsel, I am of the opinion from the material available on record that there is ground for presuming that accused persons have committed offence punishable under sections 325 read with section 34, 308 read with section 34, 506 IPC. Let charges be framed accordingly.
