Disposed Bail Application Order

1. The present bail application has been moved on behalf of the accused-applicant **Sankata** in Case Crime No. 187/2026 under Sections 105, 191(2), 190 BNS, P.S. Hargaon, District Sitapur.
2. In connection with the present bail application, an affidavit of **Anoop** has also been filed stating that this is the first bail application of the accused-applicant. No other bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, nor is any bail application pending or rejected.
3. The brief fact of the case is that the complainant Rabia, wife of late Raqib, alleged that on the night of 15.05.2026 at about 10:00 p.m., Brajrani, wife of Birju, telephonically called her husband to her house. Pursuant to which, her husband went to the said place. It is alleged that co-accused Birju, his brother-in-law (Saadhu) Sankata and two unknown persons, having made prior preparations, assaulted the deceased (Complainant's Husband) with kicks, fists, lathis and sticks, causing grievous injuries to him. Thereafter, the injured was taken to CHC Hargaon through Ambulance and was subsequently referred to District Hospital, Sitapur for further treatment. However, during the course of treatment on 16.05.2026, he succumbed to the injuries sustained in the incident.
4. Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused-applicant and D.G.C. Criminal for the State and perused the record.

5. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant stated that the accused-applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case due to enmity, whereas he is completely innocent. Accused-applicant has no connection with the said incident. Incident is based on fake and fabricated facts. Accused-applicant is a resident of village Bijaispur, P.S. Laharpur, Sitapur which is far away from the village of the co-accused persons. There is no independent witness of the said incident. The accused-applicant has no previous criminal history. The accused-applicant, if enlarged on bail, is ready and willing to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by this Hon'ble Court and shall not misuse the liberty of bail granted to her and will appear before the Court on each date of hearing.
6. Per contra, learned D.G.C. Criminal and learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed this bail application.
7. Case diary and material available on record have been examined. From the perusal of the record, it appears that there are specific allegations against the accused-applicant Sankata that he, along with co-accused Birju and others, had participated in the assault upon the deceased after making prior preparations. The deceased sustained grievous injuries in the said incident and subsequently succumbed to those injuries during treatment on 16.05.2026. Considering the nature and gravity of the accusations, the manner in which the offence is alleged to have been committed, the specific role attributed to the accused-applicant, and the fact that the incident resulted in the death of the victim, this Court does not find any sufficient ground for grant of bail to the accused-applicant at this stage. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court does not find it a fit case for granting bail to the accused-applicant. Hence, the bail application moved on behalf of accused-applicant is liable to be rejected.

ORDER

This bail application moved on behalf of the accused-applicant **Sankata** in Case Crime No. 187/2026 under sections 105, 191(2), and 190 of the BNS, P.S. Hargaoon, District Sitapur is hereby, **rejected**.
