

CRM 175 of 2020

State versus Raj Kumar

Present: Sh. Raman Vats, APP for the State.
Accused Raj Kumar S/o Suraj Bhan, R/o Barwa, Tehsil Siwani in person.

File taken up again in National Lok Adalat as accused appeared before the Bench and has stated that the challan notice be disposed of in National Lok Adalat as he is ready to deposit the fine amount, if so imposed by the Bench. Statement of accused in this regard recorded separately. Formal notice of accusation was served upon the accused to which he pleaded guilty and did not claim trial. As per the challan accused was found to be driving the vehicle without driving licence, without pollution certificate, insurance and without helmet. The accused is held guilty for offence punishable under the provisions of Motor Vehicle Act.

Heard in quantum. In view of the circumstances and explanation by accused and legal provisions, a fine of Rs. 400/- is imposed upon the accused. In default of payment of fine, convict will undergo simple imprisonment for fifteen days. **Fine paid** and receipt be issued accordingly. Papers be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
