1. Case called out. Application supported with affidavit was presented on behalf of the applicant/ complainant for acceptance of the above-mentioned final report.

2. It is averred in the application filed on behalf of the applicant/ complainant that, “the complainant lodged a complaint against Zubair at P.S. Kairana under the relevant provisions. During the course of investigation the police submitted final report, which has been placed before this Court. The complainant is fully satisfied with the final report submitted by the police and does not wish to pursue any further proceedings against the opposite party. It is, therefore, prayed that the final report be accepted.”

3. The complainant was examined as C.W.1 and has deposed that, “I used to send my daughter (minor victim girl) daily to Zubair’s place for Urdu class. On 01.03.2021 she (minor victim girl) had also gone to Zubair’s place for Urdu class. When all the other children returned home, my daughter (minor victim girl) did not come back. We searched at Zubair’s place and throughout the village but did not find her. Thereafter, at the villagers’ suggestion, I got a written complaint typed, affixed my thumb impression to it, and on 01.03.2021 submitted that complaint to Kairana Police Station. I do not wish to pursue this matter further. I have no objection to the final report submitted by the Police Station Kairana, District Shamli, which has been placed before this Court, and I request that the Court may kindly accept that final report.”

4. Heard Ld. SPP for the State and perused the case file.

5. On perusal of the case file, it is reflected that the minor victim girl was 16 years old as per records. She and her father, the complainant, have denied the allegations in their respective statements. The minor victim girl has denied the allegations even in her statement recorded U/S 164 Cr.P.C. The complainant has

presented application supported with affidavit for acceptance of final report which is placed on record and he was examined as C.W. 1 in Court where he has state that he has no objection in accept of the final report in the present matter. In view thereof, let the Final Report 10/2021, Rahisu Vs. Zubair in the present matter be accepted. Let the file be consigned to the record room as per rules.
