1. The instant Bail Application No. 1842/2026 has been moved on behalf of accused applicant **Rambhawan Maurya** in crime No. 262/2025 in P.S. Jagdishpur, District Amethi for grant of bail.

2. The prosecution story in brief is that the informant, Bharat Kori, lodged an FIR at P.S. Jagdishpur stating that on 27.08.2025, he had gone to Trauma Centre, Tiloi with his wife for treatment. On returning at about 3:00 PM, he found that Rampati (wife of Babadin), Rambhawan (son of Babadin), and Dinesh (son of Ramnath), along with 12-13 unknown persons, had cut down about 42 eucalyptus trees standing on his land (Gata No. 140) and were loading them onto a tractor, when he objected, they abused him in filthy language, attempted to assault him and threatened to kill him.

3. Submission of Learned Counsel for applicant is that this is his first bail application. No other bail application is pending before Hon'ble High Court or any other court. The applicant is fully innocent. he accused/applicant has no previous criminal antecedent. Therefore, it is prayed to grant the bail.

4. Notice is served upon the informant, he is not present in the court. Learned Counsel for the prosecution opposed the bail application.

Heard and perused the record.

5. From a perusal of the record, it is apparent that the accused/applicant is named in the FIR. The allegation against him is that he, along with other co-accused persons, unlawfully entered the informant's land, cut and removed about 42 eucalyptus trees, abused the informant in filthy language, chased him with the intention to assault, and threatened to kill him. The FIR was lodged after 10 days of the alleged incident and no explanation for the delay has been provided. The applicant is on interim bail and has not violated any of the conditions imposed upon him. The prosecution has not presented any prior criminal history of the accused. The co-accused persons Rampati Kori and Dinesh Pasi have already been enlarged on bail by the Court. The role assigned to the present applicant in the alleged occurrence is similar to that of the said co-accused. After completion of investigation, the charge sheet has been filed and the case is pending at the stage of trial. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the applicant is liable to be released on bail.

Order

Applicant **Rambhawan Maurya** is hereby released on bail on furnishing fresh P.B.s of Rs. 30,000/- each with one surety each in the like amount and after filing undertakings to the effect that:

1. The applicant/accused shall appear before the Court in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under Chapter 33 of the Code of Criminal Procedure / Section 35 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.
2. The applicant/accused shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused or suspected.
3. The applicant/accused shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer, nor shall he tamper with the evidence.
4. The applicant/accused shall remain present before the Court on the dates fixed and shall fully cooperate in the trial.
