Matter is fixed for consideration.

Today an application under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC is moved on behalf of the plaintiff seeking amendment of the plaint.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

This is a suit for declaration and permanent injunction filed by the plaintiff Ram Milan against the defendants. By way of present application, the plaintiff is seeking amendment in para 9 of the suit in respect of valuation for purpose of jurisdiction and court fees. It is submitted that inadvertently in valuation para for relief of declaration the suit was valued at Rs.200/- whereas the same has to be at Rs.14,00,000/-.

The suit is still at the initial stage and summons have not been issued so far. Therefore, the application under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC moved by the plaintiff is hereby disposed off as allowed. Amended plaint filed along with the application is taken on record.

Issue summons for settlement of issues on the amended plaint to the defendants on taking steps by the plaintiff through all available modes, returnable by the next date of hearing. Steps be taken within seven days.
