Today the case is fixed for SR.

Ld APP is present.

Accused Pinku Barman is present before the Court today pursuant to receipt of summons.

Ld Defence counsel Smt. S. Debbarma appears on behalf of the accused person Pinku Barman by executing Vokatalnama.

Ld. Special PP Mr. B. Deb is present for the prosecution.

Accused copy is prepared today and is duly supplied to the accused person as per Section 207 of CrPC.

As prayed for by both sides, I am of the opinion to explain the substance of accusation to the accused person today itself.

Accordingly, the substance of accusation of offences punishable U/s. 3(a) of the Railways Property(Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966 is read over to the accused person and explained to him in Bengali and on being asked, the accused person persistently pleaded guilty and

submitting he is very poor, living from hand to mouth.

At this stage, a petition pleading guilt to the offence aforementioned is filed by the accused person through his Ld. engaged Counsel.

On being convinced that the accused person pleaded guilt voluntarily, the plea of guilt of the accused person is accepted.

The accused Pinku Barman is hereby convicted of offence punishable U/s. 3(a) of the Railways Property(Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966.

The convict prayed for mercy when he was heard on the point of sentence and voluntarily undertook not to commit any such act in the near future and thus prayed to be treated leniently submitting that this is first offence.

Therefore, after considering all the circumstances and facts into consideration I take a lenient view and having regard to the nature and gravity of offence as well as the submission of the convict Pinku Barman, he is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 300/- id to suffer SI imprisonment of 10 (ten) days for the commission of offence punishable u/s 3(a) of Railways Property (Unlawful

Possession) Act, 1966.

Fine money, if realized from the convict, be deposited to the treasury by challan through the Nazir of the Chief Judicial Magistrate establishment, West Tripura, Agartala under appropriate head.

The Nazir of the Chief Judicial Magistrate Establishment, West Tripura, Agartala is directed to deposit the fine money of Rs. 300/- to the treasury by challan.

The case is thus disposed of uncontested on conviction.

Make necessary entry in the TR.

Fine money of Rs.300/- is realised from the convict Pinku Barman vide challan bearing machine serial no. 307706 dated **23.06.2023.**
